Woman's Board Annual Report 2015 Presidents Message

The Woman's Board had another momentous year in 2015. Again, our success was due to the efforts of our members taking on tasks, large and small, to help us reach our goals. And thanks to all of you who attended our fundraisers and participated in the efforts of DKH to make our legislators aware of the problems facing our hospital and others.

With your help, we

- Donated a total of \$72,872.33 to DKH
 - ✓ Completed our pledge for one anesthesia cart and urinalysis equipment in June;
 - ✓ Donated \$41,000 from our reserve funds for a second anesthesia cart
 - ✓ Pledged \$81,000 (\$41,000 for a third anesthesia cart, \$40,000 for a Medtronic NIM Nerve Monitoring System for the OR).
- Completed renovation of The Gift Shop for a cost of \$33,525 (Budgeted \$40,000).
- Amended our Bylaws March 30, 2015. Major changes as reflected in the Bylaws include:
 - ✓ Membership open to everyone
 - ✓ Two types of membership Member & Director
 - ✓ Deletion of Para-Medical Scholarship. The scholarships benefited individuals rather than meeting the needs of DKH
 - ✓ Replacement of "Ways and Means" with "Fundraising Committee"
 - ✓ Establishment of a "Board Development and Governance Committee"
 - ✓ Establishment of a "Finance Committee."
- Changed our Quarterly Luncheons to be more social, with possible DKH guest speakers
- Changed our Executive Board meetings to include Officers and those of you who have chosen to remain Directors.
- Began scheduling Vendor Sales through The Gift Shop with help of Amy Franklin.

We held two new fundraisers, a *Valentine Dance* and a *Guest Bartender Night*. Both were well attended, very successful and introduced Woman's Board to new segments of the community. And, we continued with fundraisers that our members and the public have come to anticipate.

I wish to thank everyone who has provided support, input and friendship to me during my term as President. I am proud to have served the membership in support of DKH and to have served the vision of all the women who came before us. With your help, we will continue to support DKH in their mission to provide quality, integrated healthcare to the approximately 72,000 residents in their service area. Volunteering is priceless in the satisfaction it gives back to each of us in knowing that we have made a difference in our community.
